Who Is The Derby For?

The derby is for children ages 8 to 17. There are exceptions to the age limits for drivers who have previously raced.

The stock division is for racers 8 – 13.

Stock cars can accommodate a racer up to approximately 5'3" tall and 125 lbs. Because painting is not permitted on the stock car shell, drivers have their choice of purchasing one of three colored shells: red, white or blue.

The super stock division is for racers age 10-17.

Super stock cars can accommodate a racer up to approximately 6'0" tall and 150 lbs.

How Do I Build A Car?

Building a soap box car is **easier** than you think. All the parts you need are included in the kit. No cutting or drilling is required. The kit can be assembled in a weekend using only simple hand tools. Your whole family can help! Make them part of your racing team.

Rules

The Richmond Soap Box Derby is run under the rules of the All American Soap Box Derby.

Current plans and rules can be found on the All American Soap Box Derby web site. Racers using older cars are advised to review the current rules. The final decision on rules at the local race is made by the local Derby Director.

How Can I Find A Sponsor For My Car?

Families, business, community associations, schools and other organizations can sponsor a racer. Many racers find more than one sponsor to reduce the cost for each individual sponsor. Be sure to tell potential sponsors:

As a sponsor, their logo can go on the car and will appear wherever the car is displayed. The sponsor's name will also appear I the race day program and be announced during the car's race. This should provide good visibility for your sponsors!

Review the list of corporate sponsors listed on this brochure. Please do approach them since they are already derby sponsors.

Stock division rules do not allow painting on the stock division car. You may decorate a stock division car with decals.

What Is Included In The Car Kit?

Everything needed to build your racer including the shell, precut floorboard, brake and steering assemblies, drilled axle sets, mounting and construction hardware, assembly instructions and helmet. Z-glass wheels must also be ordered at the time you order your car kit.
